This position will initially be filled as a 6-month contract, with the possibility of an extension or full-time permanent employment.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

This role will be an integral part of the Putumayo (Colombia) and Oriente (Ecuador) multi-disciplinary exploration team. Primary responsibilities will be to work alongside experienced geophysicists, petrophysicists, and reservoir engineers to technically mature and lead prospects through internal peer reviews and stage-gate processes. Prospect characterization includes clastic and carbonates, in diverse trapping configurations from stratigraphic, combination, and structural.

Acute working knowledge of full petroleum system analysis for clastic and carbonate resources, with Monte Carlo quantitative risk and resource analysis, is imperative for this role. The candidate will be expected to provide clear, concise messaging related to geologically diverse and challenging prospects to executive-level decision makers.

Additional responsibilities include:

- Assistance in planning and monitoring the execution of high-impact exploration wells, with timely look-back analysis and regulatory reporting.
- Providing mentorship to junior technical staff.
- Contribution to Play-Based-Exploration analysis on clastic and carbonate play types, at both basin- and prospect-level scope.
- Lead generation and prospect maturation.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 15+ years' industry experience; preference given with demonstrated exploration hydrocarbon discoveries within the international stadium.
- Working knowledge of fractured carbonate plays a plus.
- Team player with strong motivation to deliver as part of an integrated team.
- Ability to work within constrained timelines on an array of parallel projects, at varying levels of detail.
- Possesses the ability to work with minimal direct supervision.
